

Exporting References from ACM Digital Library to EndNote using direct export


1. Click on the title of the article in the search results to open the article record.




2. Select EndNote from the options in the Export Citation window.




3. Open the file with EndNote.







NOTE: The first time you export a record from ACM, you might be prompted to choose a filter. Select ACM Digital Library from the list. The filter is already installed.
