

## Exporting References from ScienceDirect to EndNote using direct export

You cannot save marked records in ScienceDirect. If you move to another search results page, the records you marked on the previous page will be unselected. You need to work one search results page at a time, but you can change the number of search results on a page to 50 or 100.

1. Mark the references you wish to export records for.

2. Click Export at the top of the search results.



3. Select Export citation to RIS in the Export menu

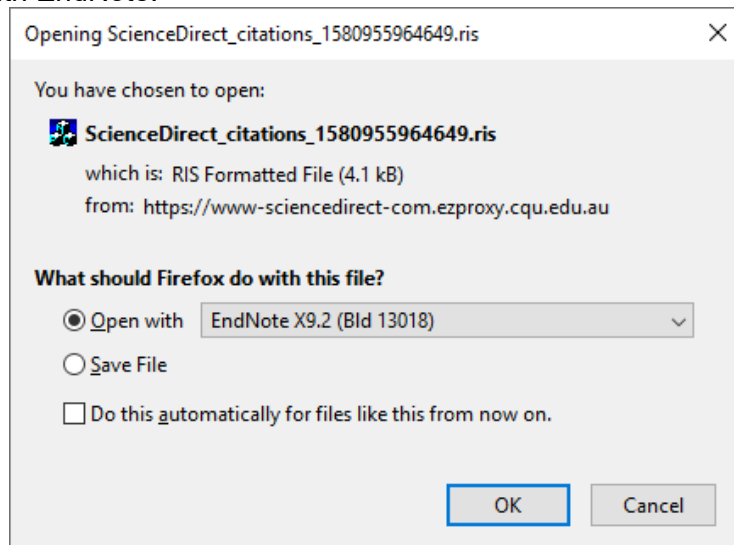

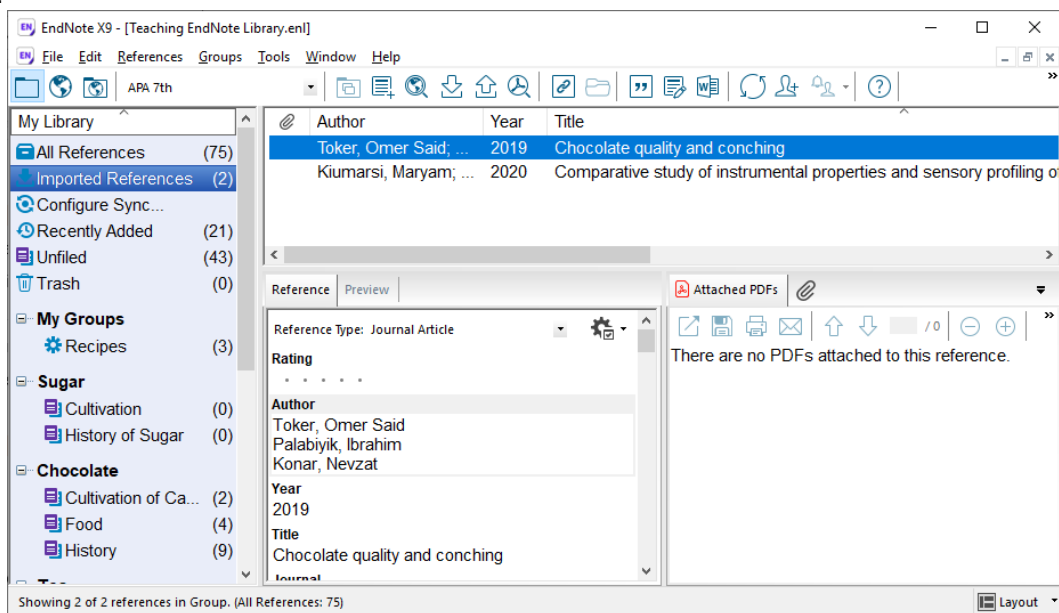
