

Exporting References from Springer Journals Online to EndNote using direct export


- 1. Click on the title of the article in the search results to open the article record.
- 2. Click Cite this article or scroll down to the About this article section. Click Download citation.



3. Open the file with EndNote.



4. The reference will be imported automatically. It will display in the Recently Added group.



Please note: Due to the structure of certain database records, information may occasionally be imported into incorrect fields within your EndNote library. These need to be edited manually. If you have any difficulties downloading references, contact the Library via teasac@cqu.edu.au
